

The Heathman Restaurant & Bar, 1001 SW Broadway (1)

Convenient location about a block away from the Hilton. Upscale bar with a few beers on tap, cocktails, and wine. Room for small groups only. Enter at the sign for the Heathman Restaurant.

Jake's Grill, 611 SW 10th Ave. (2)

Supper club classic restaurant. Large copper-topped full-service bar. Great happy hour values when you eat in the bar area. Food menu. Can be crowded at happy hour.

Higgins Restaurant & Bar, 1239 SW Broadway (3)

Great atmosphere in an upscale but comfortable setting. Popular bar & restaurant with an interesting crowd. Good for small to mid-size groups. Excellent locovore menu.

Ringlers Pub (at the Crystal Ballroom), 1332 W Burnside St. (4)

A McMenamins Brewery. Pool tables, large bar, lots of seating. A good place for large groups of grad students. Food menu.

Kells, 112 SW 2nd Ave. (5)

Irish bar, room for large & small groups. Bar with good character & mixed crowd. Food menu. Cigar bar in the basement. Can be rowdy. Ride the red or blue max (free) east to the Oak/SW 1st Ave station.

Clyde Common, 1014 SW Stark St. (6)

Portland cocktail bar. Variety of scotches & bourbons—even absinthe (the real stuff!). Good for small to mid-size groups. Locovore menu.

Tugboat Brewing Company, 711 SW Ankeny St. (7)

Low-key pub, small selection of brewed draft beers. Good for talking, small to mid-sized groups. Bring your own book or borrow one from the shelves in the place. There is a real Emmy award behind the bar.

Henry's 12th St. Tavern, 10 NW 12th Ave. (8)

Enter on Couch St. (rhymes with hooch) & 12th Ave. Outdoor seating, very large beer selection on tap. Popular! Any group size. Food menu.

Teardrop Lounge, 1015 NW Everett St. (9)

Chic cocktail bar. Creative cocktail menu. Best for small groups. Can be crowded. Reach it using the Portland Streetcar (free in this area!).

The Lotus, SW 3rd & Salmon (10)

Locals bar. Diner grill, classic wooden bar. Can accommodate any size group. 70's, 80's, early 90's music every day. Small food menu.

Virginia Café, 820 SW 10th (11)

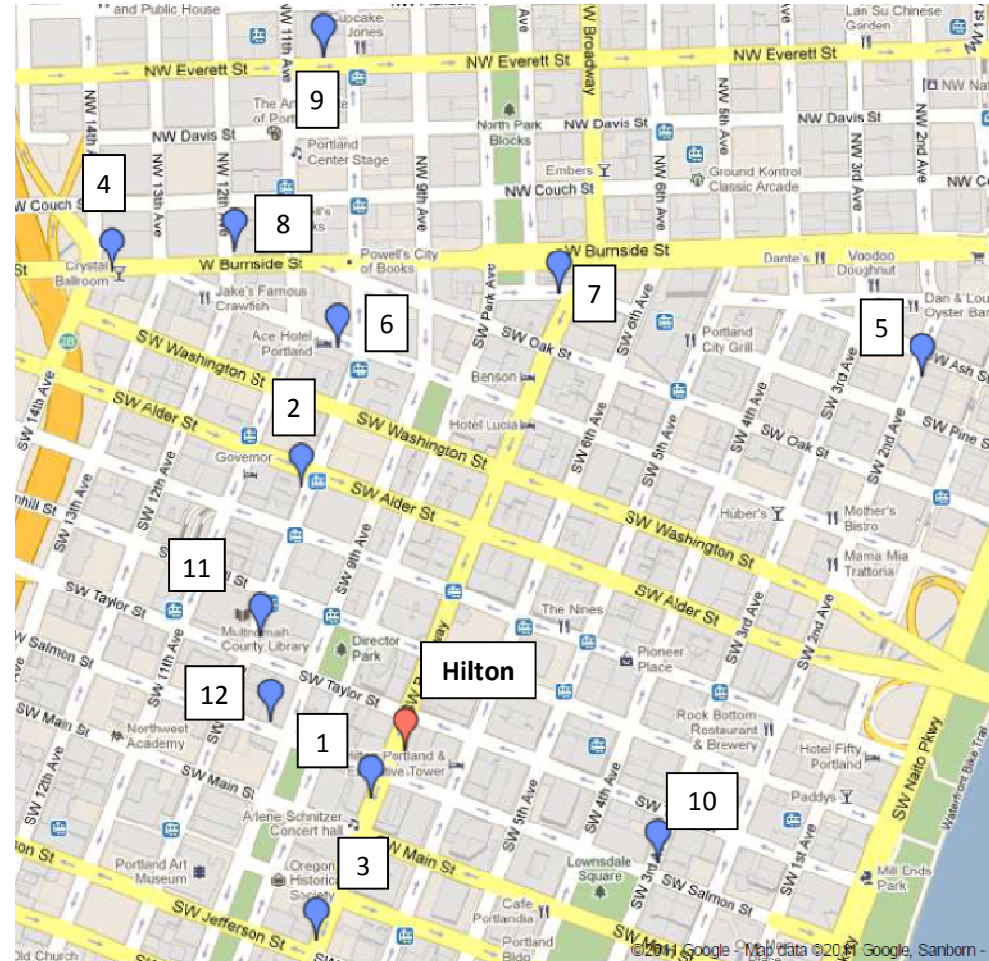
Quintessential Portland bar & cafe. Estab. @ 1914. Read its colorful history on the menu. Small groups, a good conversation bar. Food menu.
